Pets must be brought in a carrier marked with the owner's name, address and two phone numbers. Owners must have documentation of up-to-date rabies vaccinations for their pets. Owners are responsible for taking care of their pets. It is recommended pet owners bring minimal pet supplies, such as food and water, to a county public shelter.

ESSENTIAL ITEMS TO BRING TO A SHELTER

Prescription medication • Foods that meet unusual dietary requirements • Special items for elderly or disabled Identification and proof of residency • Important papers • Supplies for children and infants (diapers, formula)

Chargers for electronic devices • Books, games, toys for entertainment

Extra clothing, pillows, blankets and hygiene supplies

Bring anything you need to make yourself comfortable. Cots are not provided except for certified special needs persons. Shelters should be utilized when no other safe housing is available.
