ANALYSIS:

- A re-entry program will provide coordination between governmental and non-governmental agencies to reduce the recidivism of persons released from incarceration.
- Will reduce the cost of incarceration by providing resources to help ensure persons released become productive members of society.

BACKGROUND:

This project has been proposed by the Lake County Public Safety Coordinating Council and was presented to the Lake County Legislative Delegation in January 2015. The project proposes the creation of an offender re-entry program that would coordinate services for individuals re-entering our community from incarceration by providing coordination of support services such as job training, transportation, employment, clothing, healthcare and other services provided by nongovernmental and governmental agencies. The program is expected to reduce the cost of incarceration of re-offenders by providing needed services.
