

Mean Center of Population By Year

The center of population is the point at which an imaginary, weightless, rigid, and flat (no elevation effects) surface representation would balance if weights of identical size were placed on it so that each weight represented the location of one person. More specifically, this calculation is called the **Mean Center of Population**.
