A public hearing on the ordinance to adopt the proposed 2030 Comprehensive Plan will be held at 9:00 a.m., or soon thereafter, on Tuesday, May 25, 2010 (if necessary, the hearing will continue on Wednesday, May 26, 2010 at 1:00 p.m.), in the County Commissioners Chambers, 2nd Floor, Round Administration Building, 315 West Main Street, Tavares, Florida.

The proposed 2030 Comprehensive Plan shall be available for review at the Lake County Department of Growth Management, Planning & Community Design Division, 5th Floor - Administration Building - Room #510, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, at least ten (10) days prior to the hearing.

Interested parties may appear at the hearing and be heard with respect to the proposed Ordinance.

Lake County 2030 Comprehensive Plan

Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 286, Florida Statutes, Section 286.0105, if any person decides to appeal any decision made by the Board of County Commissioners with respect to any matter considered at this public hearing, he or she will need a record of the proceedings, and that, for such purposes, he or she may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record may include the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
