Dear Mr. Eubanks:

Pursuant to Florida Statute 162.3184(3), Lake County is transmitting a copy of the enclosed Comprehensive Plan Map Amendment to the Department of Economic Opportunity. The amendment is being submitted under the expedited state review process.

On July 30, 2013 the Lake County Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing and approved **Transmittal** of the attached amendment (SLPA#13/7/1-1). The public hearing was duly noticed and advertised pursuant to Chapter 163.3184(11), Florida Statutes.

The amendment applies county-wide and therefore includes lands within the Green Swamp Area of Critical State Concern. The amendment does affect lands within the Wekiva Study Area and Wekiva River Protection Area.

The proposed ordinance, the analysis and a future land use map depicting the location of the amendment are included in the package. One paper copy and two electronic copies on DVD are also included. This notification has also been provided to all appropriate agencies on this date.
