

CR 455 EXTENSION PD&E STUDY




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About the Project


In March 2018, Lake County began the CR 455 Extension Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study to consider proposed transportation improvements from Schofield Road to Hartwood Marsh Road in Lake County, Florida. This corridor lies in unincorporated Lake County and partially within the limits of the City of Clermont. The length of this Study area is approximately 4.7 miles in length.

A **Project Development and Environment** (PD&E) **Study** is an environmental and engineering process used to document *social, economic, natural, and physical environmental impacts* associated with a proposed transportation improvement project.

The purpose of this Study is to determine the location and conceptual design of feasible build alternatives for roadway improvements and their social, economic and environmental effects. As alternatives are identified and evaluated, the Study team will consider this corridor's setting, the area's mobility needs, and the public's input. There are many opportunities for the public to share their ideas and concerns throughout the Study. It is anticipated that the Study will be completed by December 2019.
