#### Informational Comments

The Offices or Departments of the County involved with the review process have provided informational comments to inform you of Code requirements and/or processes that will be required as you move forward with the development process. The informational comments are listed below.

## Office of Planning and Zoning

- 1. Please be advised that prior to commencement of park operations a recorded plat showing the location and legal description of the wetland tracts shown on Sheet CT.01 of the approved site plan shall be required. The plat effort will be jointly administered by the Office of Planning and Zoning and the Office of Parks and Trails. Please be advised that park construction shall not encroach within 50-feet of the jurisdictional wetland line.
- 2. Please be advised that the park entrance sign that shown on Sheet SP.03 and SD.06 is for informational purposes; the sign must be permitted through a separate permit process.

# **Environmental Review (Office of Planning and Zoning)**

- 1. Please be advised that the Land Management Plan states that gopher tortoises will be relocated from the subject property to the Russakis Ranch. Please provide a copy of the relocation permits prior to commencement of any construction/grading activity or disturbance.
- 2. It is recommended that the subject property be managed in accordance with the provided Land Management Plan.

#### **Public Works Department**

A Commercial Driveway Connection Permit will be required for the connection to Max Hooks Road. This permit should be applied for now and approval of the permit is required prior to commencement of construction.

# Office of Public Safety (911 Addressing)

All permanent structures (including restrooms, concession buildings, maintenance buildings, etc.) will require unique address numbers to be assigned.
