## Summary of Ordinance

The purpose of this ordinance is to update the existing regulations to address open air gatherings and special events. The ordinance will clarify that these types of events shall only occur if the event or use is permitted within the zoning district where the property is located. The ordinance provides for application and submittal requirements for a special event site plan. Changes are also proposed for Special Event Permits requiring review by Public Safety and a copy of that ordinance is attached for your information but does not require any action by the Planning & Zoning Board.

WHEREAS, the Lake County Land Development Regulations contain minimal requirements for open air gatherings and special events; and

THE CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, as requests to conduct open air gatherings and other special events have increased over the last few years, it is necessary to update the existing regulations to better address the needs of the community and to streamline application processes to promote economic development activities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners has determined that it is in the best interests of the citizens of Lake County to revise its regulations regarding these types of events.

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**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Lake County, Florida as follows:
