ORDINANCE SUMMARY

Chapter 3 of the Land Development Regulations (LDR) regulates zoning. The Board requested that hay production be permitted in the industrial zoning district pending the development of the property for industrial uses. Agricultural uses are an integral part of Lake County's economic base and are permitted within all land use categories pursuant to the Comprehensive Plan.

This ordinance proposes to amend the Table of Permitted and Conditional Uses in the LDR to allow agricultural use of industrial property, limited to hay production. Hay production is a low-impact crop requiring minimal soil manipulation and limited number of harvests, and is not expected to be incompatible with adjacent uses.

The specific amendments to the Land Development Regulations necessary to implement this proposal are as follows:

1. Addition of agriculture as a Permitted Use within the Industrial zoning districts in the Zoning Table, with a specific note that hay production is the only permitted agricultural use in the Industrial zoning districts.

Additions to the existing regulations are shown in <u>underline</u> and deletions are shown as strikethrough. Where three asterisks ("* * *") appear, it indicates that no changes occurred between the previous and following text or sections.
