## **Summary of Ordinance**

The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend Lake County Code, Appendix E, Land Development Regulations ("LDR"), Section 3.06.03, entitled "Permitted Parking," to limit the number of boats on residential lots.

Changes are shown as follows: Strikethrough for deletions and <u>Underline</u> for additions to existing Code sections. The notation "\* \* \*" shall mean that all preceding or subsequent text remains unchanged (excluding any renumbering or relettering that might be needed).

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## ORDINANCE 2018-

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LAKE COUNTY, FLORIDA; AMENDING LAKE COUNTY CODE, APPENDIX E, "LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS" SECTION 3.06.03 ENTITLED "PERMITTED PARKING;" PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; PROVIDING FOR FILING WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS,** the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") desires to amend Chapter III of the Land Development Regulations to update the requirements governing boats or recreational vehicles parked on lots or parcels; and

**WHEREAS,** on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2018, this Ordinance was heard at a public hearing before the Lake County Planning & Zoning Board, who considered this ordinance and recommended approval; and

**WHEREAS,** on the XX day of XXXX, 2018, this Ordinance was heard at a public hearing before the Board; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board determined that these amendments are in the best interests of the citizens of Lake County, Florida.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Board of County Commissioners of Lake County, Florida, as follows:

**Section 1.** Recitals. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

**Section 2.** <u>Amendment.</u> Section 3.06.03, Lake County Code, Appendix E, Land Development Regulations entitled "Permitted Parking," is hereby amended as follows:

**3.06.03 Permitted Parking.** The following types of vehicles are permitted to park in the zoning districts listed in 3.06.01 provided they meet the specific conditions of any one or more of the paragraphs listed herein:
