I live just off skyline drive on saltsdale me and my wife drive this north section of road every day, and with increase traffic from the new northlake park we would like to see a more permanent repair of the embankment where the road drain is.

The drain is partially plugged with a rat living or sleeping under a piece of rug at the lower end of the culvert. we have citrus trucks and other business trucks traveling through that section every day and when we have to move to the edge or off to feel safe about getting by them it's upsetting especially to my wife that a washout is so close to the edge of the paved road. many time the trucks will not move off the paved road because they know that low area of ground is very soft with leaves the cars no choice.

after I talked to the local district three folks they nicely put a load of dirt in the gully but this has been going on for years. we've live here for six or seven years. The low area is a pond when it rains. please if you can do something more permanent more than just our family would appreciate it.
