Re: Follow up on June 11, 2014 Site Meeting- Drainage Concerns; 35145 Marshall Road

Dear Mrs. Saieva:

I appreciate the opportunity to have met with you at your residence earlier last week to discuss your drainage concerns. Per our discussion, please find attached documents which demonstrate a historic water flow pattern across your property toward a much larger Lake Lincoln than that recently experienced. Also included are Saint Johns Water Management District compliance letters regarding the automotive repair shop and Pebble Creek development for which you expressed concern.

I understand your frustration with the situation noting your frame of reference of the last 15 years with no runoff issues at your property. Unfortunately, as seen in the attached documents, there is clearly a longer term historic drainage pattern of water flow from south of your property near State Road 44 northward across your property to the Lake Lincoln basin.

Also as we discussed, there appears to be an opportunity for you to address the runoff crossing your property by constructing a system of swales to channel the water around your house. As I pointed out in my visit, there are portions of your rear yard which are higher in elevation than your patio which serve to direct runoff toward your house instead of away from it. Since 2007 the County requires and inspects new single family homes for these swales under our Code by what is known as "Lot Grading". While your home would be exempt from inspection due to acreage size, the same principle would apply in that positive drainage away from your home must be provided. You may wish to consult a civil engineer or landscape architect for guidance on developing a drainage plan to retrofit on your property.

The St. Johns River Water Management District received the As-Built Certification (Form EN-45) from your engineer on August 15, 2012, certifying that all components of the stormwater management system have been built substantially in accordance with the approved plans and specifications. Dear Mr. Hannon:

The District received your letter of March 3, 2008. I inspected the project with your agent on February 26, 2008. I observed that the project has been largely constructed, specifically that the proposed roadway impervious surfaces, curb and inlet collection system and stormwater ponds have been constructed. This permit expired on July 7, 2007. I understand that you propose to place finish asphalt pavement on the streets and complete sodding or seed and mulch of the stormwater management ponds within the next 60 to 90 days.

The proposed construction is consistent with the specification adopted under this permit. As the impervious surfaces, collection system and stormwater management facilities were constructed prior to the expiration date of this permit, the proposed work to finish the project does not require further authorization from the District. Therefore, no Environmental Resource Permit is required prior to construction.

Please be aware that the permit determination made in this letter is based on the information that you provided and as described herein. If the description of the proposed activities is incorrect, or if any of the facts change, or if the District's permitting thresholds change in the future, it is recommended that you contact District staff to assure compliance with District permit requirements.

This letter applies only to the permit requirements of St. Johns River Water Management District and does not relieve you of meeting the permit requirements of local, county, or other legally constituted authorities.
