
Stormwater inspector looked at the pipe ... there is fresh disturbance in the area – a bag of riprap looks like it was pulled out of the pipe.

Suspect that both headwalls need to be replaced, but won't know exactly until they are unearthed.

Erosion is the dirt that has slowly, over time, washed down and covered the headwalls.
