LAKE COUNTY ROAD OPERATIONS

You may recall my phone call on 2/11/15 when I informed you that rainwater from the new road work was flowing down my driveway. I don't know exactly who you referred this information to but some millings were spread on top of the limerock. Not exactly what I expected because in no way did this prevent the storm water from washing out my driveway. I repeat, the water flows from the highway, down my driveway, washes out the millings and the limerock. Even a small rain event creates hazardous gullies and I have no intention of being on standby with my shovel for the rest of my life. Frankly it hasn't rained very much yet this year but yesterday I had one inch and I had several gullies a foot deep and a foot wide. The water continues to flow off the roadway even after the rain has stopped. This is a serious problem for me but I don't believe it is my responsibility and I am writing to you in the hope that you may be able to offer a permanent resolution to the issue. Now that the rainy season is here I would appreciate your prompt attention to this matter.
