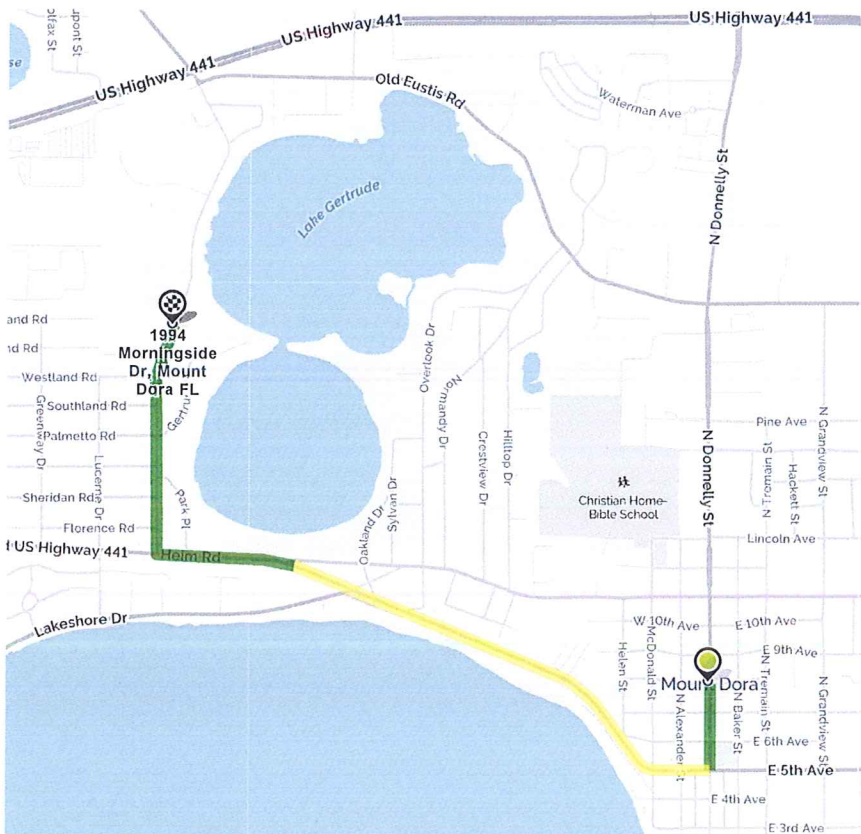

Good afternoon Jim,

I'm writing on behalf of the consensus of the neighborhood. It looks like my efforts have been in vain to obtain enough signatures on petitions. I have only received one more.

The neighborhood consensus seems to be, since we are (and have been paying taxes) for storm water abatement to the County in our property taxes every year, the County should fix the drainage problem at the corner of Sylvan Point Drive and Gertrude place, as a part of the County's storm water maintenance budget. Buddy Atkins told me about 20 or so years ago, the currently installed drain and pipe was cleared and the swales and culverts under the driveways were installed / repaired / cleaned out to allow the water from the drain to move toward the lake and not back up the intersection.

As I have stated previously, the majority of the water originates from Morningside Drive and then backs up in the intersection due to the grass in front of the drain and the drain being clogged up.

The consensus of the neighborhood is the County needs to come fix our water remediation and then we will look at what to do about having the roads paved and repaired.

I want to thank you and your team for all the hard work and time you took putting a plan in place for our neighborhood. I'm sorry I haven't been more successful, but with several houses either being rented and / or being sold (on the market), I don't have enough neighbor participation to get the petitions signed.

Please let me know what the County is willing to do to correct our storm water runoff problem and when the work can be scheduled.

Thanks again for your help on this.
