INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN LAKE COUNTY, FLORIDA AND THE CITY OF EUSTIS FOR

KURT STREET MULTI-PHASE INFRASTRUCTURE AGREEMENT

THIS IS AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT by and between Lake County, Florida, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter the "County," and the City of Eustis, a municipal corporation organized under the laws of the State of Florida, hereinafter the "City.

WHEREAS, Section 163.01, Florida Statutes, provides that local governments may enter into interlocal agreements to make the most efficient use of their powers by enabling them to cooperate with other localities on a basis of mutual advantage; and

WHEREAS, Section 335.0415, Florida Statutes, provides that public roads may be transferred between jurisdictions by mutual agreement, and

WHEREAS, Kurt Street is a road located in Lake County which runs from US 441 North to SR 19, as described in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, and hereinafter referred to as the "Kurt Street", and

WHEREAS, Kurt Street is in need of resurfacing and sidewalk repairs (the "Project"), and

WHEREAS, there has been disagreement as to whether it is County or City responsibility for maintenance of Kurt Street; and

WHEREAS, County and City have come to an agreement on how the improvements to Kurt Street will be made and paid for, and which entity shall be responsible for the future maintenance of Kurt Street after such improvements are made; and

WHEREAS, the Project will generally be funded and constructed in three phases, more particularly described in Exhibit "B," attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the County and City will share in the estimated Nine Hundred Thousand Dollar (\$900,000.) cost of the Project over a three year time frame; and

WHEREAS, the Project cost share shall be fifty percent for the County and fifty percent for the City.

- NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual terms, understandings, conditions, premises, and covenants hereinafter set forth, and intending to be legally bound, the parties hereby agree as follows:
- Recitals. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. County Obligations. County shall make the improvements to Kurt Street as described in Exhibit B. The County shall comply with all applicable provisions of the Florida Statutes regarding the bidding of construction services, including Section 255.0525, Florida Statutes, and Section 255.20, Florida Statutes. The County intends to utilize its existing on-call contracts for road resurfacing and milling, pavement base repair and sidewalk construction. The County shall be solely responsible for construction of the Project. The County will provide the plans, process any change orders, and manage the day to day project inspection. The County will budget its share of the funding for the project in the Five Year Transportation Construction Program.
- 3. City Obligations. The City shall provide payment to the County of a total of \$150,000.00 annually over a period of three fiscal years, for an estimated funding total to the County of \$450,000.00. The City shall remit to the County the payments provided for herein on October 15, 2015, October 15, 2016 and October 15, 2017. Upon final completion and acceptance of the Final Phase of the Project, the County shall send a final invoice to the City for any outstanding amounts due and owing. If the Project is completed under budget, and City has made all three payments to County, County shall refund City the appropriate amount within twenty (20) days of final acceptance of the Project. If County completes the Project prior to all three payments being made by City, the final payment to be made by City shall be adjusted as provided above based on actual cost.
- 4. Construction Schedule. It is understood that County has the option to complete the project in a shorter time frame and in less than the three phases that are contemplated in Exhibit B. The City funding obligation shall remain as stated in Section 3. In the event that the County completes the project in less than three years, the third year final payment from the City to the County will be adjusted to reflect the actual cost share of the project.

- 5. Ownership and Maintenance of Completed Project. In accordance with Florida Statute 335.0415, City and County agree that upon completion of a Project Phase, the City shall take ownership and maintenance responsibility for that portion of Kurt Street.
- 6. Term and Termination. This agreement shall become effective upon both parties executing the agreement and it shall remain in force until completion of the Project and payment of all sums due bereunder.
- 7. Modifications. Unless otherwise specified herein, no modification, amendment, or alteration of the terms or conditions contained herein shall be effective unless contained in a written document executed by the parties hereto, with the same formality and of equal dignity herewith.


