Dear Mrs. Niezgodski:

As I promised earlier this week, I rode out to your home this morning and looked at the road situation on your street and at the intersection that you had mentioned to me during our call. As you know, you live on a road that is not maintained by the County. The Board of County Commissioners has authorized the Public Works Department to provide enough maintenance on non-maintained roads that are publicly dedicated such that emergency vehicles would be able to access properties on these roads. I was able to drive to your house and through the intersection using a two wheel drive vehicle. I did notice that sand is accumulating (particularly at the intersection) and of course, the lack of rain has exacerbated the situation. But at this time there should not be an issue with emergency vehicles traversing these roads. I have asked the Public Works Department to continue to monitor the roads in this area, and if they become impassible for emergency vehicles, emergency maintenance will be done.

Also, as we discussed, the ultimate solution appears to be having the roads in this area improved and paved. The County has a program where the County will pay 1/3 of the cost of such an improvement with the balance of the costs paid by owners of property on each side of the road. Before the Board will proceed with such a project, a majority of the property owners generally must consent. If this solution is something that you think you and your neighbors would be interested in, please let me know and I will have the County Right-Of-Way Division begin the process. Should you have any further questions or comments, do not hesitate to contact me.

I went to the residence of Ms. Nucoles and found many yards of dirt washed into her yard. No clay was visible, however I am sure it is there under the sand. Before we put the clay down on Sleepy Hollow in 2006, emergency vehicles could not have made passage. The clay we put down on non-maintained roads is minimal, for as directed, we are to only make the roads passable. There will always be problems with road material washing into the Nucoles residence because they are at the very bottom of a steep four way intersection of dirt, non- maintained roads. The only way to prevent this problem would be to pave the roads. I have attached photos of the problem.
