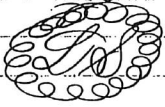

This Indenture made and entered into this Twenty  
Seventh day of October A.D. Eighteen Hundred and  
Eighty two; Between John W. Souverville and his  
wife Harriet Souverville, of the County of Orange

Company a body corporate under the laws of  
the State of Florida party of the second part;  
Witnesseth That the said parties of the first part for  
and in consideration of the advantages derived  
by them through the construction of the Leesburg  
and Indian River Railroad and the sum of  
One dollar lawful money of the United States  
to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is  
herby acknowledged have given granted  
conveyed sold alieneed and conveyed  
and by these presents do give grant bargain  
sell assign and convey unto the said party  
of the second part its successors and  
assigns forever the right of way for the  
construction of the line of the Leesburg  
and Indian River Railroad through  
the following described lands situated
