This Indenture made and entered into this Twenty  
Eighth day of October A.D. Eighteen hundred and  
Eighty two between Aaron F. Cooke of the County  
of Orange and State of Florida party of the  
first part and Leesburg and Indian River  
Railroad Company a body corporate under  
the laws of the State of Florida party of the  
second part; Witnesseth that the said party of  
the first part for and in consideration of the  
advantages derived by him through the  
construction of the Leesburg and Indian  
River Railroad and the sum of One Dollar  
lawful money of the United States to him in  
hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby ac-  
knowledged has given granted bargained sold  
aliened and conveyed and by these presents  
do give grant bargain sell and convey  
unto the said party of the second part its  
successors and assigns forever the right of  
way for the construction of the line of the  
Leesburg and Indian River Railroad  
through the following described lands  
situated lying and being in the County of  
Orange and State of Florida: that is to  
say the S.E. 1/4 of N.E. 1/4 and N.E. 1/4 of Section  
thirty two (32) and the N.E. 1/4 of Section thirty  
three (33) Township Nineteen (19) South of Range Twenty  
Second (22) East. Said right of way to be  
Sixty feet wide measured each side of and at  
right angles to the line of said Railroad now  
located as about to be located as the centre line  
of main main track of said Leesburg and  
Indian River Railroad together with all and  
singular the hereditaments and appurtenances  
thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining  
and all the estate right title interest possession
