The applicant proposes to construct church (18,573 ft<sup>2</sup>), which will include sidewalks, parking, utilities and stormwater infrastructure. A dry pond is proposed to serve as the stormwater system for the church. The 3.95-acre parcel includes herbaceous and developed areas. Carpet grass, lantana and other herbaceous species make up the majority of the area of the project. A 1-story medical care facility is located in the southwest corner of the project. The surrounding land use consists of medium density homes, roads and recreational uses. As proposed, the project will add 1.85 acres of impervious surface. During the on-site field investigation, no evidence of surface waters, wetlands or wetland dependant species were observed.
