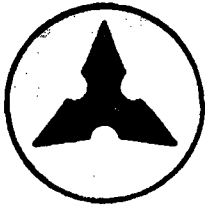

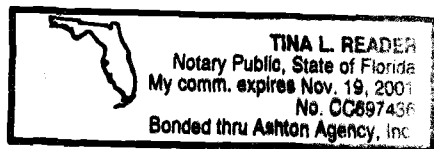

NOTICE OF AGENCY ACTION TAKEN BY THE ST. JOHNS RIVER WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT

Notice is given that the following permit was issued on April 23, 2001, Lennar Land Partners, Attn. Robert Aherns; 1110 Douglas Avenue, Suite 2040, Altamonte Springs, Florida 32714, permit #40-069-19411-11. The project is located in Lake County, Section 4, Township 23 South, Range 26 East. The permit authorizes construction of a surface water management system, called Kings Ridge North Phase III (a.k.a. Highgate Phase II and Sussex), consisting of a 52.91-acre, 253-lot single-family residential subdivision, and improvements to a portion of an existing paved road. The system will provide for conveyance of stormwater runoff into four existing retention ponds. The receiving waterbody is Lake Felter.

The file(s) containing the application for the above listed permit is available for inspection Monday through Friday except for legal holidays, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the St. Johns River Water Management District (District) Headquarters, Hwy 100 W., Palatka, Florida 32178-1429. A person whose substantial interest are affected by the District permitting decision for an administrative hearing in accordance with section 120.57, F.S. Petitions must comply with the requirements of Florida Administrative Code Rule 40C-1.511 and 40C-1.521 and be filed with (received by) the District Clerk located at District Headquarters, Highway 100 West, Palatka, Florida 32177. Petitions for administrative hearing on the above application(s) must be filed within fourteen (14) days of publication of this notice or within nineteen (19) days of the District depositing notice of this intent in the mail for those persons to whom the District mails actual notice. Failure to file a petition within this time period shall constitute a waiver of any right(s) such person(s) may have to request an administrative determination (hearing) under section 120.57, F.S., concerning the subject permit. Petitions which are not filed in accordance with the above provisions are subject to dismissal.
