



#### NOTICE OF AGENCY ACTION TAKEN BY THE ST. JOHNS RIVER WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT

Notice is given that the following permit was issued on March 26, 2003.

Lennar Development, 151 Wymore Road, Suite 4000, Altamonte Springs, Florida 32714, permit #40-069-19411-16. The project is located in Lake County, Section 4, Township 23 south, Range 26 East. The permit authorizes modification and operation of an existing surface water management system know as Kings Ridge, to authorize con-struction of the Aberdeen Phase III @ Kings Ridge, a 12.92-acre project consisting of 59 single-family residential lots, streets, infrastructure and associated stormsewer conveyance system. No impacts to wetconveyance lands or surface waters are authorized by this permit. The receiving waterbody is Lake Felter.



application for the above listed permit is available for inspection Monday through Friday except for legal holi-days, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the St. Johns River Water: Management District (District) Headquarters, 4049 Reid Street, Palatka, Florida 32178-1429. A person whose substantial in-terests are affected by the District permitting decision for an administrative hearing in accordance with sections 120.569 and 120.57, Florida Statutes, or may choose to pursue mediation as an alternative remedy under section 120.573 under section 120.573, Florida Statutes, before the deadline for filing a petition. Choosing mediation will not adversely affect the right to a hearing if mediation does not result in a settlement. The procedures for pursuing mediation are set forth in section 120.573, Florida Statutes, and rules 28-106,111 and 28-106,401-404 Florida Administrative Code. Petitions must comply with the requirements of Florida Administrative Code Chapter 28-106 and be filed with (received by) the District Clerk located at Headquarters, Highway 100 West, Palatka, FL 32177. Petitions for administrative hearing on the above application(s) must be filed within twenty-one (21) days of publication of this notice or within twentysix (26) days of the District depositing notice of this in-tent in the mail for those persons to whom the District mails actual notice. Failure to file a petition within this time period shall constitute a waiver of any right(s) such person(s) may have to request an administrative determination (hearing) under sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., concerning the subject permit. Petitions that are not filed in accordance with the above provisions are sub-lect to dismissal.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the District's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice of intent. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the District on the applicant have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

In compliance with your request for notice of applications received in the above referenced counties, enclosed is a copy of Section C - Environmental Resource Permit Notice of Receipt of Application and a location map for each permit application applied for within the above referenced counties.

Permit applications under the Individual section are Individual permit applications that require the District Governing Board to act on (approve or deny) the application. For these applications, you are advised to notify the District within 14 days of receipt of this letter of any questions, objections, comments or information regarding the proposed system. Those who file a written request for further information regarding the permit application will be furnished the information requested prior to the Governing Board meeting at which the application will be considered.

Permit applications under the General section beginning with "42" or "40" are Standard General permit applications that are issued from the Service Centers. For these applications, any substantial objections to the permit application must be made in writing and filed with (received by) the District Clerk, located at P.O. Box 1429, Palatka, Florida 32178-1429, on or before 14 days from date of posting of the notice of receipt of application. The posting date is shown on the bottom of Section C in the shaded block designated as "For Agency Use Only", and adjacent to "Date to be posted". A substantial objection means a written statement directed to the District which identifies the objector, concerns hydrologic or environmental impacts of the proposed activity and relates to applicable rule criteria. If a substantial objection is received, the procedures applicable to an Individual permit application will be followed. The receipt of a substantial objection will entitle you to an individual notice prior to the Governing Board meeting at which the application will be considered.
