

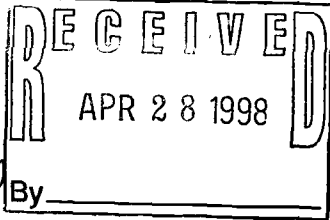

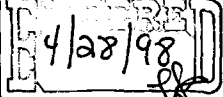

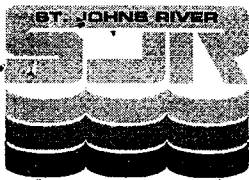

The procedures for pursuing mediation are set forth in section 120.573, Florida Statutes, and rules 28-106.111 and 28-106.401-.405 Florida Administrative Code. Petitions must comply with the requirements of Florida Administrative Code Rule 40C-1.521 and be filed with (received by) the District Clerk, located at District Headquarters, Highway 100 West, Palatka, Florida 32177. Petitions for administrative hearing on the above application(s) must be filed within fourteen (14) days of publication of this notice or within nineteen (19) days of the District depositing notice of this intent in the mail for those persons to whom the District mails actual notice. Failure to file a petition within this time period shall

constitute a waiver of any right such person may have to request an administrative determination (hearing) under sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., concerning the subject permit application. Petitions which are not filed in accordance with the above provisions are subject to dismissal. NOTICE OF RIGHTS

1. A person whose substantial interests are or may be determined has the right to request an administrative hearing by filing a written petition with the St. Johns River Water Management District (District), or may choose to pursue mediation as an alternative remedy under sections 120.569 and 120.573, Florida Statutes, before the deadline for filing a petition. Choosing mediation will not adversely affect the rights to a hearing if mediation does not result in a settlement. The procedures for pursuing mediation are set forth in sections 120.569 and 120.57, Florida Statutes, and rules 28-106.111 and 28-106.401-.405, Florida Administrative Code. Pursuant to District rule 40C-1.511, Florida Administrative Code, the petition must be filed at the office of the District Clerk at District Headquarters, Highway 100 West, Palatka, Florida 32178-1429 within nineteen (19) days of the District depositing notice of its intent in the mail (for those persons to whom the District mails actual notice) or within fourteen (14) days of newspaper publication of the notice of its intent (for those persons to whom the District does not mail actual notice). Such a petition must comply with District rule 40C-1.421, Florida Administrative Code.
2. If the Governing Board took action which substantially differs from the notice of intent to grant or deny the permit application, a person whose substantial interests are or may be determined has the right to request an administrative hearing. Pursuant to District rule 40C-1.511, Florida Administrative Code, the petition must be filed at the office of the District Clerk at District Headquarters, Highway 100 West, Palatka, Florida 32178-1429, within nineteen (19) days of the District depositing notice of final agency action the the mail (for those persons to whom the District mails actual notice) or within fourteen (14) days of newspaper publication of the notice of its final agency action (for those persons to whom the District does not mail actual notice). Such a petition must comply with District rule 40C-1.521, Florida Administrative Code.
3. A substantially interested person has the right to a formal administrative hearing pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, where there is a dispute between the District and the party regarding an issue of material fact. A petition for formal hearing must comply with the requirements set forth in Section 40C- 1.521(2), Florida Administrative Code.
4. A substantially interested person has the right to an informal hearing pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes, where no material facts are in dispute. A petition for an informal hearing must comply with the requirements set forth in Section 40C- 1.521(2), Florida Administrative Code.
5. A petition for an administrative hearing is deemed filed upon delivery of the petition to the District Clerk at the District headquarters in Palatka, Florida. (Section 40C-1.013, Florida Administrative Code)
6. Failure to file a petition for an administrative hearing, within the requisite time frame shall constitute a waiver of the right to an administrative hearing. (Section 40C-1.511, Florida Administrative Code)
7. The right to an administrative hearing and the relevant procedures to be followed are governed by Chapter 120, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 40C-1, Florida Administrative Code.
8. An applicant with a legal or equitable interest in real property who believes that a District permitting action is unreasonable or will unfairly burden the use of his property, has the right to, within 30 days of receipt of notice of the District's intent to grant or deny a permit application, apply for a special master proceeding under section 70.51, Florida Statutes, by filing a written request for relief at the office of the District Clerk located at District headquarters, Highway 100 West, Palatka, Florida 32178-1429. A request for relief must contain the information listed in subsection 70.51(6), Florida Statutes.
9. A timely filed request for relief under section 70.51, Florida Statutes, tolls the time to request an administrative hearing under paragraph no. 1 or 2 above. (Paragraph 70.51(10)(b), Florida Statutes) However, the filing of a request for an administrative hearing under paragraph no. 1 or 2 above waives the right to a special master proceeding. (Subsection 70.51(10)(b), Florida Statutes)
10. Failure to file a request for relief within the requisite time frame shall constitute a waiver of the right to a special master proceeding. (Subsection 70.51(3), Florida Statutes)

NOTICE OF RIGHTS

11. Any substantially affected person who claims that final action of the District constitutes an unconstitutional taking of property without just compensation may seek review of the action in circuit court pursuant to section 373.617, Florida Statutes, and the Florida Rules of Civil Procedures, by filing an action in circuit court within 90 days of rendering of the final District action, (Section 373.617, Florida Statutes).
12. Pursuant to Section 120.68, Florida Statutes, a person who is adversely affected by final District action may seek review of the action in the district court of appeal by filing a notice of appeal pursuant to the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, within 30 days of the rendering of the final District action.
13. A party to the proceeding before the District who claims that a District order is inconsistent with the provisions and purposes of Chapter 373, Florida Statutes, may seek review of the order pursuant to Section 373.114, Florida Statutes, by the Florida Land and Water Adjudicatory Commission, by filing a request for review with the Commission and serving a copy on the Department of Environmental Protection and any person named in the order within 20 days of adoption of a rule or the rendering of the District order.
14. For appeals to the District courts of appeal, a District action is considered rendered after it is signed on behalf of the District, and is filed by the District Clerk.
15. Failure to observe the relevant time frames for filing a petition for judicial reviews described in paragraphs #11 and #12 or for Commission review as described in paragraph #13 will result in waiver of that right to review

General Description OF APPLICATION NO.4-069-0326AM6-ERP:

This application is for a surface water management system consisting of a 34.37-acre residential development with 157 lots within the Kings Ridge master development. The surface water management system includes a conveyance system discharging to one existing retention pond within the master drainage system and two proposed retention ponds and stormsewer system.

Authority: chapter 373 F.S.; chapter 40C-4.041(1)(2)(b)2 F.A.C.

Existing Land Use: Abandoned citrus grove

Hydrologic Basin(s): 07

Receiving Water Body(ies): Lake Felter Class:III

Staff Comments:

The project is located approximately 3 miles south of Clermont on the east side of US Highway 27 (See Attachment A).

A stormwater permit #42-069-1062 was issued for Phase I of the Kings Ridge development on June 28, 1995. This permit authorized the construction of a stormwater management system consisting of a 17.85-acre project including an entrance road, model homes, and sales center. A standard general permit (40-069-0196) was issued for Phase II. Phase II of the project consisted of three dry-retention ponds and two, existing, dry retention ponds (two depressional areas), and one temporary dry retention pond. Phase III of the project (4-069-0326) consists of a residential development with 145 lots and 11 holes of golf for a future 18-hole golf course. The surface water management system for Phase III includes 299.27 acres of area (38 acres of subdivision and 261.27 of mass grading and 10 retention ponds). Subsequently, Permits 4-096-0326M through 4-096-0326M5 have been issued for the site.

Whitehall at Kings Ridge is a 34.37-acre project within Kings Ridge P.U.D. consisting of 157 lots, construction of an access road into State Road 27, and construction of a right turn lane on State Road 27. A portion of this project lies within the previously permitted King Ridge Phase IV master system (permit 4-069--0326AM2-ERP), which encompassed 430 acres. The system includes discharge to one existing dry retention pond and two proposed retention ponds and stormsewer system. There is no discharge off site in the pre-development condition, and there will be no discharge in the post-development condition.

Under the post-development condition, the existing surface water management system has been designed to retain the entire run-off generated by the 25-year, 96-hour storm event on-site (In the analysis of the storm events, infiltration during the storm event was assumed.), and recover the total volume within fourteen (14) days. The system is also designed to provide the required water quality treatment, and recover this volume within seventy two (72) hours following the storm event. The proposed construction has no encroachment to a flood plain area. The site is located within the Ocklawaha River Hydrologic Basin. The design as proposed meet the applicable Ocklawaha Basin criteria. Most of the master system has been constructed. The applicant has demonstrated that the existing and proposed surface water management system will provide treatment and recovery of the required pollution abatement volume, and volume storage of runoff, pursuant to chapter 40C-42, 40C-41, and 40C-4, F.A.C.

The proposed project site consists of cleared, grassed areas and planted pine trees. There are no wetlands within the project area.

The proposed project will have no unacceptable adverse secondary and cumulative impacts to wetlands, water quality, and upland habitat for aquatic and wetland dependent fish or wildlife "listed" as endangered, threatened, or of special concern. Staff has determined that the proposed project is consistent with the wetland review criteria in sections 12.2 - 12.3.8, A.H./MSSW,ERP.

Staff believes this project, as proposed, is consistent with the objectives and criteria of the District set forth in Chapters 40C-4, 40C-41, and 40C-42, F.A.C.

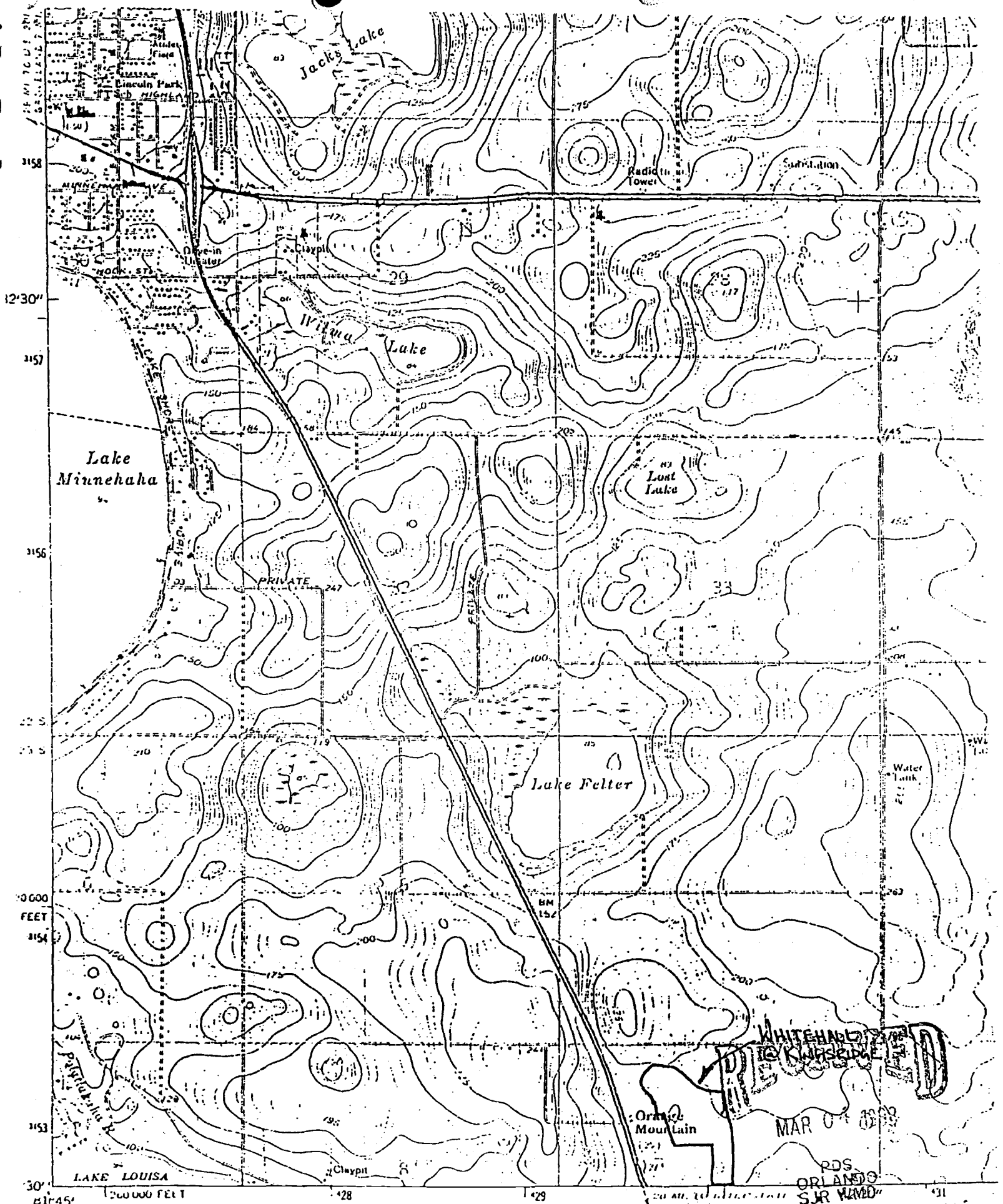

If the design permeability rates cannot be verified, the permittee must obtain a modification of this permit demonstrating that the design criteria and objectives of Chapter 40C-4, F.A.C. are met.

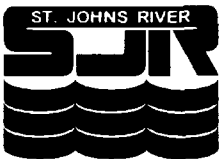
