





NOTICE OF RIGHTS

- 1. A person whose substantial interests are or may be determined has the right to request an administrative hearing by filing a written petition with the St. Johns River Water Management District (District), or may choose to pursue mediation as an alternative remedy under Sections 120.569 and 120.573, Florida Statutes, before the deadline for filing a petition. Choosing mediation will not adversely affect the rights to a hearing if mediation does not result in a settlement. The procedures for pursuing mediation are set forth in Sections 120.569 and 120.57, Florida Statutes, and Rules 28-106.111 and 28-106.401-.405, Florida Administrative Code. Pursuant to Chapter 28-106 and Rule 40C-1.1007, Florida Administrative Code, the petition must be filed at the office of the District Clerk at District Headquarters, P. O. Box 1429, Palatka, Florida 32178-1429 (4049 Reid St., Palatka, FL 32177) within twenty-six (26) days of the District depositing notice of District decision in the mail (for those persons to whom the District mails actual notice) or within twenty-one (21) days of newspaper publication of the notice of District decision (for those persons to whom the District does not mail actual notice). A petition must comply with Chapter 28-106, Florida Administrative Code.
- 2. If the Governing Board takes action which substantially differs from the notice of District decision, a person whose substantial interests are or may be determined has the right to request an administrative hearing or may choose to pursue mediation as an alternative remedy as described above. Pursuant to District Rule 40C-1.1007, Florida Administrative Code, the petition must be filed at the office of the District Clerk at the address described above, within twenty-six (26) days of the District depositing notice of final District decision in the mail (for those persons to whom the District mails actual notice) or within twenty-one (21) days of newspaper publication of the notice of its final agency action (for those persons to whom the District does not mail actual notice). Such a petition must comply with Rule Chapter 28-106, Florida Administrative Code.
- 3. A substantially interested person has the right to a formal administrative hearing pursuant to Section 120.569 and 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, where there is a dispute between the District and the party regarding an issue of material fact. A petition for formal hearing must comply with the requirements set forth in Rule 28-106.201, Florida Administrative Code.
- 4. A substantially interested person has the right to an informal hearing pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes, where no material facts are in dispute. A petition for an informal hearing must comply with the requirements set forth in Rule 28-106.301, Florida Administrative Code.
- 5. A petition for an administrative hearing is deemed filed upon delivery of the petition to the District Clerk at the District headquarters in Palatka, Florida.
- 6. Failure to file a petition for an administrative hearing, within the requisite time frame shall constitute a waiver of the right to an administrative hearing (Section 28-106.111, Florida Administrative Code).

NOTICE OF RIGHTS

- 7. The right to an administrative hearing and the relevant procedures to be followed are governed by Chapter 120, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 28-106, Florida Administrative Code and Section 40C-1.1007, Florida Administrative Code.
- 8. An applicant with a legal or equitable interest in real property who believes that a District permitting action is unreasonable or will unfairly burden the use of his property, has the right to, within 30 days of receipt of notice of the District's written desision regarding a permit application, apply for a special master proceeding under Section 70.51, Florida Statutes, by filing a written request for relief at the office of the District Clerk located at District headquarters, P. O. Box 1429, Palatka, FL 32178-1429 (4049 Reid St., Palatka, Florida 32177). A request for relief must contain the information listed in Subsection 70.51(6), Florida Statutes.
- 9. A timely filed request for relief under Section 70.51, Florida Statutes, tolls the time to request an administrative hearing under paragraph no. 1 or 2 above (Paragraph 70.51(10)(b), Florida Statutes). However, the filing of a request for an administrative hearing under paragraph no. 1 or 2 above waives the right to a special master proceeding (Subsection 70.51(10)(b), Florida Statutes).
- 10. Failure to file a request for relief within the requisite time frame shall constitute a waiver of the right to a special master proceeding (Subsection 70.51(3), Florida Statutes).
- 11. Any substantially affected person who claims that final action of the District constitutes an unconstitutional taking of property without just compensation may seek review of the action in circuit court pursuant to Section 373.617, Florida Statutes, and the Florida Rules of Civil Procedures, by filing an action in circuit court within 90 days of the rendering of the final District action, (Section 373.617, Florida Statutes).
- 12. Pursuant to Section 120.68, <u>Florida Statutes</u>, a person who is adversely affected by final <u>District action</u> may seek review of the action in the District Court of Appeal by filing a notice of appeal pursuant to the <u>Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure</u> within 30 days of the rendering of the final <u>District action</u>.
- 13. A party to the proceeding before the District who claims that a District order is inconsistent with the provisions and purposes of Chapter 373, Florida Statutes, may seek review of the order pursuant to Section 373.114, Florida Statutes, by the Florida Land and Water Adjudicatory Commission, by filing a request for review with the Commission and serving a copy on the Department of Environmental Protection and any person named in the order within 20 days of adoption of a rule or the rendering of the District order.

NOTICE OF RIGHTS 14. For appeals to the District Court of Appeal, a District action is considered rendered after it is signed on behalf of the District, and is filed by the District Clerk. 15. Failure to observe the relevant time frames for filing a petition for judicial review described in paragraphs #11 and #12, or for Commission review as described in paragraph #13, will result in waiver of that right to review. General Description of Application Number 4-069-0357A-ERP:

This application is to authorize a surface water management system consisting of a 403acre area of mass grading and construction of a master system which consists of 23 surface water ponds, associated storm sewer, and golf courses.

Authority: Chapter 373 F.S.; Chapter 40C-4.041(2)(b)2, 40C-40.302(2)(b), 40C-

Staff Comments:

The proposed Legends project is located on the west side of U.S. Highway 27, approximately four miles southeast of Clermont, Lake County, Florida. The project is approximately 1500 feet north of Lake Louisa and is in the Ocklawaha River Basin. A previous permit, #40-069-0262-ERP, was issued on July 4, 1997, for the clearing and grading of 99.54 acres of the site's eastern portion; issued as Lake Louisa Club Mass Grading Phase I. This project is part of a DRI that includes Kings Ridge, Clermont, and the Legends (Lake Louisa Club), but is a separate project. A Consumptive Use Permit, #20-069-0093AM was issued for golf course irrigation on June 15,1998.

This application is for a 403-acre area of mass grading and construction of a master system which consists of 23 surface water ponds, associated storm sewer, and golf courses.

The existing condition of the proposed project site is sand ridge uplands. The natural topography consists of a high point in the east, three depressional areas in the south, and one depressional area in the west. The elevation of the high point is about 240 feet and the elevations at the bottom of the depressional areas range from 160 feet to 100 feet. The depressional areas are not wholly owned by the applicant. A geotechnical report shows that the depressional areas have no direct connection to the Floridan Aquifer. The project is bounded by US Highway 27 on the east and an existing Vista subdivision on the south. The general pre-development stormwater drainage direction is from the high point of the site to all directions off-site, except as bounded by US Highway 27 on the east and to the depressional areas on the west and south.

The proposed surface water management system will retain the total runoff from the 25-year/96-hour storm event. The project has a total of 23 drainage basins. Each post-development drainage basin will have a dry retention pond and the associated storm sewer. For all the dry retention ponds, the water quality treatment volume will recover within 72 hours and the total runoff volume will recover in 14 days.

There are two lined wet ponds in the system. Pond 2C is located at the entrance. The normal water elevation will be 163 feet. The total runoff volume of the 25-year/96-hour storm event will be retained above the normal water elevation and recover in 14 days. Pond 9 is a surface water/irrigation pond. Pond 9 is lined to elevation 238 feet with the pond bottom elevation at 228 feet. The normal water elevation in the pond will 236 feet. Water above elevation 236 feet will be used for irrigation. When the elevation drops below 236 feet, an on-site well or future reclaimed water from the City of Clermont shall augment Pond 9 up to elevation 236 feet. The use of groundwater is consistent with condition 25 of the consumptive use permit (permit #20-069-0093M, issued on June 15, 1998), which states "the lowest quality water source, such as reclaimed water or surface/storm water, must be used as irrigation water when deemed feasible pursuant to District rules and applicable state law." Although this pond could not recover the total volume from the first 25-year/96-hour storm event, it has additional volume to retain the total runoff of the second 25-year/96-hour storm event.

The applicant has submitted an Integraded Pest Management Plan (IPMP). Staff have reviewed and approved the IPMP.

The proposed project site consists of abandoned citrus grove, an abandoned farm house and associated structures with a long paved drive from U.S. Highway 27 to the structures, young planted pines and upland grassed areas. There are no wetlands and/or other

surface waters on site. The project will not cause unacceptable adverse secondary or cumulative impacts to upland habitats required by "listed" wetland-dependent species.

The proposed project meets all applicable conditions for permit issuance pursuant to sections 40C-4.301 and 40C-4.302, F.A.C.



Other Conditions:

- 1. The proposed surface water management system must be constructed as per the plans received by the District on August 17, 1998, and as modified by the plans received by the District on September 28, 1998, and as amended by the phase boundary map received on November 19, 1998.
- 2. Contained within the as-built report, the permittee must submit a soil analysis of the base of all the ponds verifying that the design permeability rates are provided. If the design permeability rates cannot be verified, the permittee must obtain a modification of this permit demonstrating that the design criteria and objectives of Chapter 40C-4, F.A.C. are met.

- 3. The operation and maintenance entity shall submit inspection reports to the District one year after the operation phase permit becomes effective and every year thereafter on District form EN-46. The inspection form must be signed and sealed by an appropriate registered professional, and must include the results of permeability tests of the base of all ponds verifying that the design permeabilities are met. After three consecutive inspection reports confirm the design permeabilities, the entity will no longer be required to submit permeability test results, and the inspection report requirement shall be amended to every two years. If the design permeability rates cannot be verified, the permittee must obtain a modification to the permit demonstrating that the design criteria of Chapter 40C-4 F.A.C. are met.
- 4. The permittee may obtain a Standard General Environmental Resources Permit for any construction of Phases 1 through 10 not shown on the plans authorized by this permit, when each phase is consistent with this permit and when thresholds for an Individual Environmental Resource Permit are not tripped.. If consistency is not demonstrated or Individual Environmental Resource Permit thresholds are tripped, the permittee must obtain a modification to this permit.
