

Dear Mr. O'Conner:

The District staff has completed its review of your proposal to vacate tract A of The Vistas subdivision because you believe that the tract serves no purpose that benefits the community. You mentioned that the tract cannot act as a water retention area because it is nearly at the highest elevation of the subdivision. According to the District permit files, tract A contains WRA 'A' that was required by District rule to serve as a retention area for stormwater runoff from 8.2 acres of land immediately north of your subdivision.

However, the District permit files for The Vistas and The Legends Phase I indicate that the design of The Legends golf course substantially reduces the off-site area that was intended to discharge to tract A. Based on my review of the files and a field inspection on February 16, 2001, the off-site contributing area of 8.2 acres has been reduced to approximately one-half acre by construction of the golf course fairway. On the basis of these findings, the proposed abandonment of WRA 'A' as a water retention area is considered by District staff to be a non-substantive change to the surface water management system for The Vistas.

Therefore, the District has not objection to The Vistas subdivision arranging for tract A to be vacated by the Lake County Public Works Department. Upon completion of the process, please submit a copy of the appropriate documents to the District for inclusion in the permit files.

This permit determination applies only to your letter and the proposed abandonment of WRA 'A' as a water retention area. If any information is incorrect or if any changes occur, the District staff should be contacted to ensure compliance with District permit requirements. This letter applies only to requirements of the St. Johns River Water Management District and does not relieve the Permittee of meeting the permit requirements of local, county or other legally constituted authorities.
