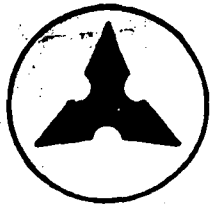

Robert Ahrens, 1110 Douglas Avenue, Suite 2040, Altamonte Springs, Florida 32714, permit # 40-069-19451-4. The project is located in Lake County, Sections 5&8, Township 23 South, Range 26 East. The permit authorizes construction and operation of a surface water management system which consists of construction of a 48.88 acre single family development (147 lots), known as Legends Phase II. This project is a land locked basin.

Notice is given that the following permit was issued on April 14, 2000. Lennar Land Partners, Attn. Robert Ahrens, 1110 Douglas Avenue, Suite 2040, Altamonte Springs, Florida 32714, permit # 40-069-19451-4. The project is located in Lake County, Sections 8&9, Township 23 South, Range 26 East. The permit authorizes construction and operation of a surface water management system consisting of constructing a golf course clubhouse, cart barn building, community clubhouse, tennis court, and parking lots. The two previously permitted dry retention ponds 2B and 7 will provide treatment, recovery, and volumetric storage of runoff for the proposed site, known as Clubhouse @ Legends. This project is a land locked basin.
