



Permit applications beginning with "42" (without an "I" in the number) or "40" are General permit applications that are issued from the Service Centers. For these applications, any substantial objections to the permit application must be made in writing and filed with (received by) the District Clerk, located at P.O. Box 1429, Palatka, Florida, 32178-1429, on or before 14 days from date of posting of the notice of receipt of application. The posting date is shown on the bottom of Section C in the shaded block designated as "For Agency Use Only", and adjacent to "Date to be posted". A substantial objection means a written statement directed to the District which identifies the objector, concerns hydrologic or environmental impacts of the proposed activity and relates to applicable rule criteria. If a substantial objection is received, the procedures applicable to an Individual permit application will be followed. The receipt of a substantial objection will entitle you to an individual notice prior to the Governing Board meeting at which the application will be considered.

Permit applications beginning with "400" are Noticed General Permit applications. For these applications, any objections as to whether the proposed activity qualifies for the requested noticed general permit must be made in writing and filed with (received by) the District Clerk, P.O. Box 1429, Palatka, Florida, 32178-1429, on or before 14 days from date of posting of the notice receipt of application. The posting date is shown
