Dear Alex:

Pursuant to our conversation this morning, I am providing you in writing the status and background for the storm water management system of the above referenced project.

Wellington Phase III is a 40C-40 modification to the master MSSW individual permit issued to Kings Ridge Phase IV and amended by Wellington Phase I and II, Permit No. 4-069-0326M2-ERP.

Please be advised that the calculations for pond 3-C, such as stage/storage, hydrologic and hydrology design information was provided with the original Kings Ridge Phase IV permit and with Wellington Phase I and II amendment to same, permit referenced above. As you can see, from the compliance calculations submitted with Wellington III, the runoff curve number for basin 3-C is significantly lower than that assumed in the Master Permit Calculations CN of 67 versus 80.
