Modica and Associates completed the preliminary environmental assessment of the Knapp Property on July 23, 1997 to document the vegetation and land-use cover, wildlife inhabiting the site, general site conditions and extent of any on-site wetlands. This site is approximately 57 acres and is located in Lake County (Section 27, Township 22 South, Range 26 East). The site is just south of SR 50 and fronts Hancock Road along the west side. The following paragraphs describe observations made during the assessment, as well as the methodologies used to evaluate the site.

The site was evaluated by using a series of belt transects and pedestrian surveys to document the vegetative communities and wildlife utilization. The transects varied from 100 to 500 feet in length and 20 to 30 feet in width. The total area of the transects covered more than 15% of the ecological community that occurs on the site. The transects were visually surveyed for plant species composition through ground-truthing. A variety of tools were used during the assessment including soils maps, aerial photographs and binoculars.

Vegetative cover at the Knapp Property was composed of only one cover type. The entire property was made up of an abandoned citrus grove which would have a Florida Land Use, Cover and Forms Classification System code of Fallow Crop Land (261). Rows of citrus trees still exist throughout the site, however the site obviously had not been maintained for many years. Common plant species observed at this site included, dog fennel (Eupatorium

capillifolium), lantana (Lantana involucrata), natal grass (Rhynchelytrum repens), ragweed (Ambrosia artemisiifolia), hairy indigo (Indigofera hirsuta), greenbriar (Smilax auriculata), muscadine grape (Vitis rotundifolia), sky-blue lupine (Lupinus diffusus), peppergrass (Lepidium virginicum), rattle box (Crotalaria spp.), groundsel tree (Baccharis halimifolia), Mexican clover (Richardia brasiliensis), passion flower (Passiflora incarnata), southern plantain (Plantango virginiaca), prickly-pear cactus (Opuntia humifusa), morning-glory (Ipomoea macrorhiza), pokeweed (Phytolacca americana), cottonweed (Froelichia floridana), camphorweed (Heterotheca subaxillaris), and various exotic and native grasses. In addition, some scattered trees were also present. These included live oak (Quercus virginiana), winged sumac (Rhus copallina), wild cherry (Prunus serotina) and common persimmon (Diospyros virginiana).

As mentioned, the Knapp Property was also evaluated to determine if any wildlife species currently utilizing the property are "listed" as Endangered, Threatened, or Species of Special Concern by the Florida Game and Freshwater Fish Commission (FGFWFC) or the United States Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS). Several wildlife species were observed on the project site at the time of the evaluation. The following is a list of those species present during the evaluation including any direct observations made and evidence of any particular species found (i.e. tracks, burrows, etc...).

Black Vulture (Coragyps atratus)
American Crow (Corvus brachyrhynchos)
Loggerhead Shrike (Lanius ludovicianus)
Northern Mockingbird (Mimus polyglottos)
Mourning Dove (Zenaida macroura)
Northern Bobwhite (Colinus virginianus)
Eastern Towhee (Pipilo erythrophthalmus)

REPTILES

gopher tortoise (Gopherus polyphemus) six-lined racerunner (Cnemidophorus sexlineatus)

MAMMALS

pocket gopher (Geomys pinetis).

The gopher tortoise was the only observed species listed in the Florida Game and Freshwater Fish Commission's (FGFWFC) Official Lists of Endangered and Potentially Endangered Fauna and Flora in Florida. The gopher tortoise is currently "listed" as a species of special concern. The FGFWFC provides four options for developers who have gopher tortoises on property that is being developed. These options include avoidance, preservation of habitat, contribution to a wildlife trust fund (i.e. contribution of money for purchase of land that is part of a gopher tortoise mitigation bank) and relocation.


