Dear Mr. Núñez,

At this time, CPH has identified that a permit from the St. Johns River Water Management District (SJRMWD) will be required for this project due to the proposed stormwater pond. Although we have corresponded with other agencies, such as the US Fish and Wildlife Service, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, etc., no other outside agency has stated the need for additional permitting.

It should be note that, due to the Palisades entry sign being replaced, it is possible that a County building permit may be required because it is a vertical construction element that is not roadway light fixture. However, because this decision is not finalized at this time, CPH judges this is as only a potential development. The SJRMWD permit, however, will be necessary for the project.
