Per the LDRs 6.06.01(F)(5)(d), excavation on agricultural properties is exempt from mining standards provided the excavated material remains on site and stored on upland areas. If the excavated material cannot be stored onsite on the upland areas, a mining conditional use permit is required.

The bigger issue lies within the Comp Plan — the FLU designation is Wekiva Sending A-1-20, which doesn't allow or permit resource extraction. On top of that, the subject property is also within the Wekiva River Protection Area. Policy I-3.3.20 *Mining and Borrow Activities within the Wekiva River Protection Area* prohibits new mines within the protection area.
