Install a temporary construction entrance within the public rights-of-way of County maintained roads. Issuance of a driveway permit does not vest any rights to the property owner for zoning, land use changes, or site improvements. The owner must follow all County procedures for permitting.

Driveway must be constructed in accordance with the Lake County Land Development Regulations and as shown on the attached sketch. Applicant holds Lake County harmless from all damages, claims, or injuries which may result from such work. Any deviation from the attached sketch must first be approved in writing by Lake County Public Works Department. Please see attached minimum requirement details for specifications.

Clay Road — No apron required — culvert pipe may be required — sod all disturbed areas.

Payed Road — Option 1: 6" limerock base and minimum 1" Type S-III Asphalt. Option 2: 6"reinforced concrete (3000 PSI) using 10 foot square of 6" x 6" wire mesh placed a minimum of 10' from edge of existing pavement. Culvert pipe may be required - Sod all disturbed areas.

In areas where sidewalks are present or planned, the driveway must include a minimum 4 foot wide path traversing the driveway apron (at a maximum 1.5% cross slope) in compliance with ADA requirements.
