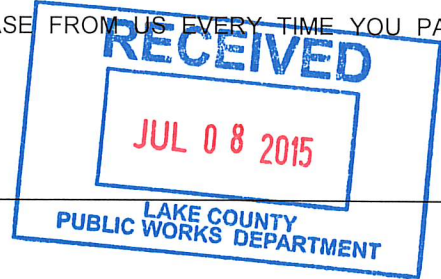

WARNING TO OWNER: UNDER FLORIDA LAW, YOUR FAILURE TO MAKE SURE THAT WE ARE PAID MAY RESULT IN A LIEN AGAINST YOUR PROPERTY AND YOUR PAYING TWICE.
TO AVOID A LIEN AND PAYING TWICE, YOU MUST OBTAIN A WRITTEN RELEASE FROM US EVERY TIME YOU PAY YOUR CONTRACTOR.

In the event that the contract for improvement is bonded, pursuant to Section 255.05 or 713.23, Florida Statutes Title 40 U.S.C. Section 270, or any other form of bond, the undersigned will look to that bond for protection and payment. The undersigned requests a copy of the payment bond and a copy of any direct contracts pertaining to the improvements for this project and agrees to any reasonable copy costs for such copy.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR YOUR PROTECTION

Under Florida's laws, those who work on your property or provide materials and are not paid, have a right to enforce their claim for payment against your property. This claim is known as a construction lien.

If your contractor fails to pay subcontractors or material suppliers or neglects to make other legally required payments, the people who are owed money may look to your property for payment, EVEN IF YOU HAVE PAID YOUR CONTRACTOR IN FULL.

PROTECT YOURSELF:

--RECOGNIZE that this Notice to Owner may result in a lien against your property unless all those supplying a Notice to Owner have been paid.

--LEARN more about the Construction Lien Law, Chapter 713, Part I, Florida Statutes and the meaning of this notice by contacting an attorney or the

Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation.

DESPITE A CERTIFIED REQUEST, THE OWNER FAILED TO PROVIDE A NOTICE OF COMMENCEMENT. MIDDLESEX PAVING, LLC RESERVES THE RIGHT TO AMEND THIS NOTICE TO OWNER.

I just wanted to follow up with you guys on the full intersection of Hancock Rd & Fosgate. I know previously it was discussed that the intersection was not going to be operational until the road work is completed. Let me know if this is still the case or if we need to complete this work prior to the start of school. The only issues I see is that the NB / SB loops will not be able to be completed and would possibly need to install temp detection for the NB / SB left turn phases. And as you know we would have to hang some temporary heads for the current alignment. Either way let me know what your thoughts are so we can plan accordingly.

SECO has moved the power lines out of our way in the last couple of weeks on the west side of the intersection.
