# EXHIBIT A – SCOPE OF WORK PORTABLE VARIABLE MESSAGE (VMS) BOARDS

### 1. SCOPE OF WORK

Portable Variable Message Boards (VMS)

- 1.1. Four (4) portable trailer mounted variable message sign (VMS) boards
- 1.2. 5' x 8' message boards with color displays
- 1.3. Full matrix and display large and small letters, symbols, and graphics
  - 1.3.1. Be able to display graphics and text within the same message
- 1.4. Equipment shall be new, of current production year, and must carry the manufacturers standard guarantee against defective parts and workmanship
- 1.5. Equipment shall be manufactured to conform to all industry standards
- 1.6. Meet the minimum specifications of Attachment 4 Specification Sheet
  - 1.6.1. Comply with all standards of The Manual for Uniform Traffic Code Devices (MUTCD), National Transportation Communications Protocol (NTCIP), and the American Association of State Highway and Transportation (AASHTO).

#### 2. CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITIES

2.1. Complete Attachment 4 – Specifications Requirements.

## 3. COUNTY RESPONSIBILITIES

- 3.1. The County reserves the right for exceptions to the solicited item. Item exceptions shall be of equal or greater precision equipment and shall be clearly documented.
  - 3.1.1. The County shall be sole judge of equality, based on the best interests of the County, and its decision in this regard shall be final.

## 4. DELIVERY REQUIREMENTS AND ACCEPTANCE

- 4.1. Delivery shall be made within ninety (90) calendar days after the issuance of a purchase order.
- 4.2. Equipment shall be delivered to Lake County Traffic Operations, 28127 CR 561, Tavares, FL 32778 with one-week advance notice of delivery.
- 4.3. Delivery shall be FOB destination. Title to the equipment shall not pass to the County until the unit has been delivered to the designated location and has been inspected and accepted by the County's Traffic Operations Supervisor.
