

BRUSH TRUCK VEHICLES**1. SCOPE OF SERVICES**

Contractor shall provide vehicles that are new, in current production year, and equipped with manufacturer published standard equipment and accessories, turnkey, and delivered to the County. No demonstrator, prototype, or discontinued models.

This is an indefinite quantity contract with no guarantee of purchase. Vehicles and devices shall be manufactured in strict conformance to industry and safety standards and in accordance with all Federal, State, or Local laws and regulations.

2. CONTRACTOR’S RESPONSIBILITIES

The Contractor shall:

2.1. Provide a quote within ten (10) business days of request.

2.2. Provide pricing on one or both of the following options:

2.2.1. Option 1: A complete turnkey build which will include the Contractor supplying the chassis.

2.2.2. Option 2: Chassis provided. The Contractor shall be responsible for all other specifications for a complete turnkey build.

3. DELIVERY REQUIREMENTS AND ACCEPTANCE

Deliveries shall:

3.1. Be made with one (1) day advance notice to the County.

3.2. Be FOB Destination.

3.2.1. Title shall not transfer to the County until vehicle has been delivered, inspected, and accepted by the County.

3.2.2. Be to Lake County Fleet Division, 30423 Independence Blvd., Groveland FL 34739.

4. WARRANTY REQUIREMENTS.

4.1. The Contractor shall warrant its products and/or services against faulty labor and/or defective material for a minimum of one (1) year from the date of acceptance.

4.1.1. All fees incurred to correct the deficiencies shall be at Contractor’s expense.

4.1.2. Deficiencies shall be corrected within thirty (30) calendar days after notification.

4.1.2.1. The County reserves the right to procure items and/or services at the Contractor’s expense should failure to provide warranty services within the specified time frame.

4.1.3. Pricing shall be provided for extended warranties (not part of evaluation).
