

EXHIBIT A – SCOPE OF WORK

REPAIR OF ROLL-OFF CONTAINERS AND COMPACTOR UNITS. REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION OF NEW COMPACTOR UNITS.

Lake County is currently accepting bids from qualified contractors for a contract to repair roll-off and recycling containers from 12 cubic yards to 50 cubic yards and other containers such as 2 cubic yard self-dumping hoppers on an as needed basis. Lake County may deliver these containers to the contractors' place of business, or the contractor may be asked to go to one of the six drop-off centers listed below to do the repair work. The contractor will supply all material for the repairs to be completed. The contractor will also perform repair and maintenance work on stationary compactors that are currently 2 cubic yards in size. The contractor will supply all parts and fluids needed for the compactor to be fully operational when repairs are completed. This work will be on an as needed basis and will be performed at a designated drop-off center from the list below.

This contract will include removal of existing stationary compactor units and installation of new compactor units in the same place on an as needed basis. The installation would include all hardware, fasteners, hoses, oil, electric lines, and any other materials needed to complete the installation not supplied by the manufacturer. Lake County will supply the compactors and would arrange for the compactors to be delivered to the drop-off center for installation. This work would be done at the drop-off centers listed below.
