

## **Request for Quotation (RFQ) for Leather Fire Helmets**

### **1. SCOPE OF WORK**

- 1.1. The purpose of this RFQ is to establish a contract, per the following specifications, terms and conditions for the purchase and delivery of Leather Fire Helmets.
- 1.2. The Office of Fire Rescue anticipates purchasing eight to twelve Phenix TL-2 model or equivalent helmets per year. Color, rank, and bend are to be determined at time of order.
- 1.3. This is an indefinite quantity contract with no guarantee on the quantity of product to be ordered or dollar volume.
- 1.4. The County reserves the right to award contracts to multiple vendors if deemed in its best interest to do so.

### **2. TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS:**

- 2.1. The product supplied shall meet all applicable technical specifications as minimum requirements. Submittals must be for the Phenix TL-2 leather helmet or equivalent meeting/exceeding the technical specifications listed.
- 2.2. County shall make the final determination if the equivalent qualifies.
  - 2.1.1 Top grade leather shell.
  - 2.1.2 High-temperature thermoplastic dome.
  - 2.1.3 Closed cell energy impact cap.
  - 2.1.4 Linear with fully adjustable comfort pad (nape strap or ratchet).
  - 2.1.5 Black Nomex and fire-retardant cotton detachable earlaps.
  - 2.1.6 NFPA compliant goggles with long strap (ESS FirePro or ATAC).
  - 2.1.7 Eight lime-yellow reflective tetrahedrons.
  - 2.1.8 D-ring on rear brim.
  - 2.1.9 Weight of 55 oz. or less.
  - 2.1.10 Colors: red, white, black, and flat black.
    - 2.1.10.1. Battalion Chief- White
    - 2.1.10.2. Captain- Red
    - 2.1.10.3. Lieutenant- Red
    - 2.1.10.4. Firefighter- Black and Flat Black
  - 2.1.11 Compliant to current NFPA 1971-2018 standard to include required NFPA-compliant goggles and earlaps.
  - 2.1.12 Bend options: Phenix, Boston, and Colorado or equivalent
  - 2.1.13 Chinstrap
  - 2.1.14 6" Custom leather shield, see attached Leather ID Shields document. [Medallion may be substituted for recessed center graphic if unavailable].

### **3. TERM OF CONTRACT**

- 3.1. Contract will be awarded for an initial one (1) year term with the option for two (2) subsequent two (2) year renewals. Renewals are contingent upon mutual written agreement.
- 3.2. Contract will commence upon the date of the purchase order.

- 3.3. Contract shall remain in effect until completion of both the expressed and implied warranty periods.
- 3.4. County reserves the right to negotiate for additional services or items of a similar nature that were not known or anticipated at the time of solicitation.
