

**EXHIBIT A – SCOPE OF WORK
MULCH DISPOSAL SERVICES**

1. SCOPE OF WORK

- 1.1. Contractor(s) shall provide hauling and disposal services of mulch and the dirt associated with mulch piles.
- 1.2. Mulch will be removed from the Solid Waste Facility located at 13130 County Landfill Road, Tavares, FL and taken to a disposal site of the Contractor's choosing.

2. CONTRACTOR RESPONSIBILITIES

- 2.1. Disposal sites shall be properly permitted and proof of permitting shall be provided by the Contractor upon County request.
- 2.2. Pricing will be at a per ton rate.
 - 2.2.1. No cubic yard pricing will be considered or accepted.
 - 2.2.2. Weights shall be taken at the scales located at the Solid Waste Facility.
 - 2.2.3. Trucks will be weighed in empty and out when loaded.
 - 2.2.4. The net weight in pounds will be divided by 2,000 pounds to provide the net tons to two decimal places.
 - 2.2.5. The net tons times the rate per ton will be the charge for that load.
 - 2.2.6. All loads must be at a legal weight before leaving the Solid Waste Facility and the drivers signature on the scale ticket is verification that the load is at a legal weight.
- 2.3. Contractor(s) shall provide hauling services upon notification by the County.
- 2.4. Contractor(s) shall complete the removal of all mulch within 45 business days of County notification. Work must be to the satisfaction of the County.

3. COUNTY RESPONSIBILITIES

- 3.1. This grinding may take place 4 to 6 times per year.
- 3.2. There is no guarantee of any quantity. The amount of yard waste to be ground into mulch is expected to be approximately 18,000 tons per year.
- 3.3. Lake County will provide a loader and operator to load the trucks.
- 3.4. There may be delays while the loader is performing other duties but the trucks will be loaded as quickly as possible.

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
